

Blended Training/Workshop day on Co-Production Approaches – Participant Briefing

Meeting Room 1, Monkton Hall, 22nd January 2018

Following a request for support from South Tyneside CCG with understanding concepts of Co-Production and how these translate in real-life projects and approaches, the following areas of focus will be delivered in a one day event. A blended learning style will include the conceptual aspects of this approach, as well a significant amount of real life project planning/discussion:

The day will include:

- What is Co-Production and what are the benefits? What is it not?!
- Creating a shared vision with stakeholders while managing expectations
- Barriers to Co-Production and how to overcome them
- Co-Production in practice – how **your** projects might include this approach

In advance, participants are asked to consider the following aspects of any upcoming projects or programmes, with the aim of discussing one or more of these projects in depth on the day:

- How patients, families and 'shop floor' staff have been involved/engaged with/consulted with to date for this project (if at all)
- Who the patient/family population related to this service/project are, and what forums exist already for them/you to link into
- Who the staff are working in this service area/project area, and how communication with them usually happens
- Are there any other key Stakeholders of influence, and how have they been involved/consulted with so far

We will explore these projects in table discussions, with the aim of creatively thinking about how Co-Production would enhance your project outcomes and benefits, and how practically that might be achieved.
